    - Psychotherapeutic combinations

#### Denominator

- Patients  $\geq$ 18 years old 245 before the measurement end date
- AND: Active problem of Major Depression  $\leq$ 245 days before measurement period

- AND: Antidepressant medication prescribed, administered or added to active medication list <=14 days after FIRST diagnosis of major depression
  - Antidepressant medication classes include:
    - Phenylpiperazine
    - SSNRI
    - SSRI
    - Tetracycline
    - Monoamine Oxidase
    - Psychotherapeutic combinations
- AND NOT
  - Diagnosed with major depression <=120 days before or simultaneously to the FIRST diagnosis of major depression
  - Diagnosed with depression <=120 days before or simultaneously to the FIRST diagnosis of major depression
